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1. Introduction

Failure to follow them may result in your paper being delayed and the effectiveness of the search capabilities offered by electronic delivery will depend upon the care used by authors in preparing their manuscripts. Therefore, contributors are strongly encouraged to read these instructions carefully before preparing a manuscript for submission, and to check the manuscript for compliance with these notes before submitting it for publication.

2. Submitting a Paper to *SAR and QSAR in Environmental Research*

Authors are encouraged to submit manuscripts electronically. Electronic submissions should be sent as email attachments using a standard word processing program, such as MSWORD or PDF. If email submission is not possible, please send an electronic version on disk along with three paper copies together with one set of high quality figures for reproduction.

Authors are also requested to submit figures of very high quality only. Poor quality figures will be asked to be replaced.

When the accepted paper is submitted in final form, please send two paper copies and a copy on disk - see [Electronic Processing](#).

As a general rule, authors can expect there to be 500 words per page in the journal. Please make sure your contact address information is clearly visible on the outside of all packages you are sending to Editors.

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SAR and QSAR in Environmental Research considers all manuscripts on the strict condition that they have been submitted only to *SAR and QSAR in Environmental Research*, that they have not been published already, nor are they under consideration for publication or in press elsewhere. Authors who fail to adhere to this condition will be charged with all costs which *SAR and QSAR in Environmental Research* incurs and their papers will not be published.

Contributions to *SAR and QSAR in Environmental Research* must report original research and will be subjected to review by referees.

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Papers must include all the statistical parameters necessary to assess the validity of the analyses. They should contain the data tables. Names and sources of computer programs must be stated.

Writing your paper

- For all manuscripts non-discriminatory language is mandatory. Sexist or racist terms should not be used.
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- Each paper should have three to six keywords. In addition to Keywords, authors are encouraged to provide three to six classification codes from the ACS classification system.
- Papers are accepted only in English.
- Manuscripts should be typed on single sides of good quality white A4 or 8 x 11 inch paper, double-spaced throughout including the reference section, with wide (3 cm) margins.

- All the authors of a paper should include their full names, affiliations, postal addresses, telephone and fax numbers and email addresses on the cover page of manuscripts.
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- Manuscripts should be compiled in the following order: title page; abstract; keywords; main text; acknowledgments; appendixes (as appropriate); references; table(s) with caption(s) (on individual sheets); figure caption(s) (as a list).
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
